

## HealthPlus of Michigan Alcohol Screening Program The TWEAK Test

**Instructions/Scoring:** A 7-point scale is used to score the test.

The “tolerance” question scores 2 points if the woman reports she can hold more than five drinks without falling asleep or passing out. A positive response to the “worry” question scores 2 points, and a positive response to the last three questions scores 1 point each.

A total score of 2 or more indicates the woman is likely to have risky drinking behavior.

One drink is defined as:

- 0.6 oz alcohol
- 12 oz beer
- 1.5 oz 80-proof alcohol
- 4-5 oz wine
