

HEALTHY MICHIGAN FAQs



➤ What is the Healthy Michigan Plan?

The Healthy Michigan Plan will provide medical, pharmacy and other benefits for people who have no health insurance and are not currently eligible for the existing Medicaid. Healthy Michigan was signed into law on Sept. 16, 2013, and will go into effect in April 2014.

➤ I have no health insurance. Can I get coverage under Healthy Michigan?

Healthy Michigan is for those aged 19-64, not currently eligible for Medicaid, not eligible or enrolled in Medicare, who meet certain income requirements. If you are eligible for Healthy Michigan, you will choose a health plan, such as HealthPlus Partners, to provide your coverage. Go to www.mibridges.michigan.gov for more info or to apply.

➤ What does the HealthPlus Partners Healthy Michigan plan cover?

Doctor visits, lab work, prescriptions, hospitalization, emergency transportation, mental health, preventive and wellness services and more. Go to www.healthplus.org/healthymichigan for more info.

➤ Can my children be covered under Healthy Michigan?

Healthy Michigan is limited to adults ages 19-64. There are other programs available, such as HealthPlus MICHild, to provide medical coverage to children who do not qualify for Medicaid. Visit www.michigan.gov/michild or call 888-988-6300 for more info.

➤ Can I keep my current doctor?

Yes, if your doctor is in the network of the health plan you choose.

➤ Will I be able to get health coverage through the Healthy Michigan Plan if I have a pre-existing condition?

Yes. The Healthy Michigan Plan will not deny coverage to individuals due to pre-existing conditions.

➤ Who is eligible to apply for the Healthy Michigan Plan?

The Healthy Michigan Plan will cover people who are:

- Ages 19-64
- Not currently eligible for Medicaid
- Not pregnant when applying for the Healthy Michigan Plan
- Earning up to 133% of the Federal Poverty Level - approximately \$15,000 for a single person and \$34,000 for a family of four.
- A resident of Michigan

➤ How do I find out if I'm eligible for Healthy Michigan?

To apply online, go to www.mibridges.michigan.gov. If you are eligible, please consider choosing HealthPlus Partners to provide your coverage.

➤ How much money can I make and still qualify for Healthy Michigan?

In April 2014, adults making less than about \$15,000 a year will qualify. Families of four making about \$34,000 a year may also qualify.

➤ Does Healthy Michigan provide free transportation?

Yes. When you choose HealthPlus Partners for your coverage through the Healthy Michigan Plan, you get free, non-emergency transportation to and from doctor appointments, and to your DHS case worker for services covered by HealthPlus Partners.

➤ What are the costs of the Healthy Michigan plan?

You may have copays ranging from \$1 to \$3. There also may be other costs based on your income, up to 2% of your income for the use of the MI Health Account.

➤ Once I sign up do I have to renew every year?

Yes, you will need to confirm you are eligible every year before your redetermination date. This is the date you became eligible for Healthy Michigan.

➤ How do I select HealthPlus Partners as my Healthy Michigan plan?

➤ What type of information will I need to apply for the Healthy Michigan Plan?

When applying, you will need information about each person applying for coverage. This includes names, birthdates, Social Security numbers, income information, tax returns and citizenship/immigration status.
